<b>Development and Health Screenings</b>	<p>1-5 points are awarded based on how the program works with families to ensure all children receive an annual health screening, a developmental screening, and referrals for follow up, if necessary.</p> <p>Notes: Chaffey College CDC meets Community Care Licensing regulation for annual health screenings and will be attending trainings for developmental screenings.</p>	
<b>Minimum Qualifications for Lead Teacher/Family Child Care Home (FCCH)</b>	<p>1-5 points are awarded based on teachers’ professional development and formal education. Highest points are awarded to teachers who hold a Bachelor’s degree or higher.</p> <p>Notes: 75% of lead teachers have Bachelor’s degree with 24 units in Early Childhood Education.</p>	
<b>Effective Teacher-Child Interactions: CLASS Assessments</b>	<p>1-5 points are awarded based on assessment scores using a tool that measures teaching quality in the areas of: emotional support, classroom organization, and instructional support.</p> <p>Notes: An independent CLASS assessment was conducted at Chaffey College CDC.</p>	
<b>Ratios and Group Size</b>	<p>1-5 points are awarded based on the average adult/child ratio and group size in each classroom. Highest points are awarded to classrooms with small group sizes and more adults per child.</p> <p>Notes: Chaffey College CDC uses 3 Teachers to 24 children ratio: group size</p>	
<b>Program Environment Rating Scale(s)</b>	<p>1-5 points are awarded based on assessment scores using a tool that measures health and safety, quality of materials, room arrangement, schedules, and interactions in the classroom and program.</p> <p>Notes: Chaffey College has current National Accreditation approved by the California Department of Education.</p>	
<b>Director Qualifications</b>	<p>1-5 points are awarded based on the director’s professional development and formal education. Highest points are awarded to directors who hold an Administrative Credential or Master’s degree.</p> <p>Notes: Birgit Monks holds a Master’s degree with over 39 units in Early Childhood Education.</p>
