
Growing Excellence in Early Learning




Quality Start San Bernardino County (QSSB) is a collaborative of early learning partners, educators, and champions who are working together to increase the quality of local early learning programs for San Bernardino County's youngest children through the development of a Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS). In 2015, these early learning partners came together to develop a strategic plan that guides the design, development, and implementation of the local QRIS. This informational brief outlines accomplishments from July 2021 to June 2022.



CSPP Quality Ratings

Sites participating in QSSB are strongly committed to providing quality care. QSSB has made the commitment to support them by offering and connecting educators to professional development opportunities. Establishing standards that define quality and measuring programs using these standards is also important. In the 21-22 program year, all California State Preschool (CSPP) sites with a valid rating were rated as Quality Plus or Highest Quality.



1,756 Early Childhood Educators Reached

Professional development coaching focused on areas of the California ORIS Rating Matrix. The majority of the Quality Improvement Plans focused on the following three areas:

42% Program Environment Rating Scale(s)

Minimum Qualifications for Lead 21% Teacher / Family Child Care Home (FCCH)

15% Effective Teacher-Child Interactions: CLASS Assessments

Program Impact

Early childhood educators realized successes as a result of their participation in QSSB. Participants reported positive impacts in how they interact with the children in the program and with each other:

> 91% have had positive changes in the way they or other staff interact with the children.

83% have had positive changes in how staff interacts with each other.
